



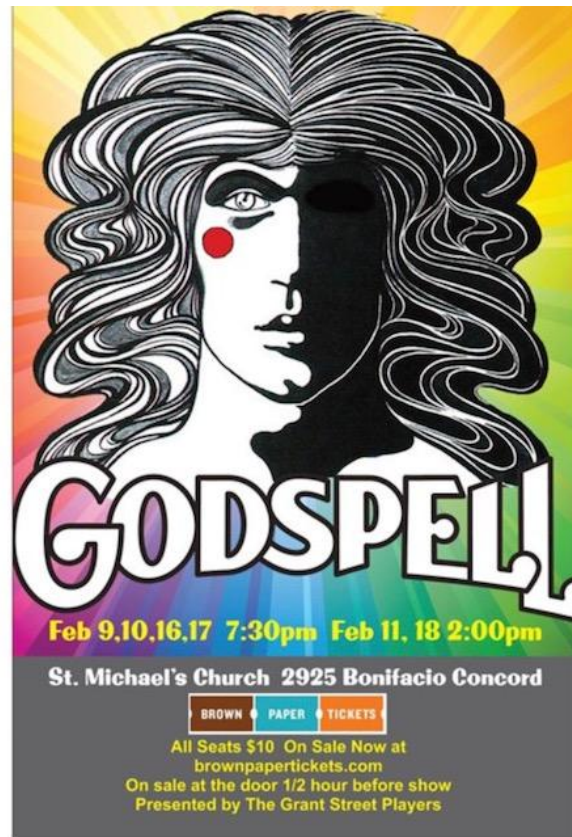

Godspell @ St Michael's

Godspell, the classic pop-rock musical based on the Gospel According to St. Matthew, will be presented at St. Michael and All Angels, Concord, February 9-18, Fridays and Saturdays at 7:30, Sunday matinees at 2:00. The show, which was just revived on Broadway in 2012, will be presented in its original version at St. Michael's featuring a high school/young adult troupe acting out and singing Christ's lessons. The high-spirited show features an energetic young cast from The Grant Street Players, a performing-arts outreach ministry of St. Michael's and St. John's, Clayton. All performers are local high school/college students eager to share this most unusual take on the gospel!

Godspell has always had close ties to the Episcopal Church. The author, John Michael Teblak, was Episcopalian, and most of the songs--including its signature tune, "Day by Day," came from the Episcopal hymnal of 1940 (and many songs remain in the 1982 hymnal). Set to new music by Steven Schwartz (Pippin, Wicked, the Disney animated classics The Hunchback of



Notre Dame and Pocahontas, among many other works), the show has been performed in many Episcopal Churches all over the country and in churches, schools, and theatres all over the world.
