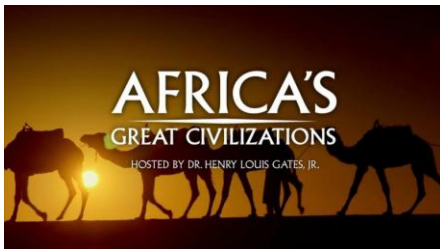
Holy Week Schedule of Service

11 AM service at St. Michaels with egg hunt and Mediterranean lunch.

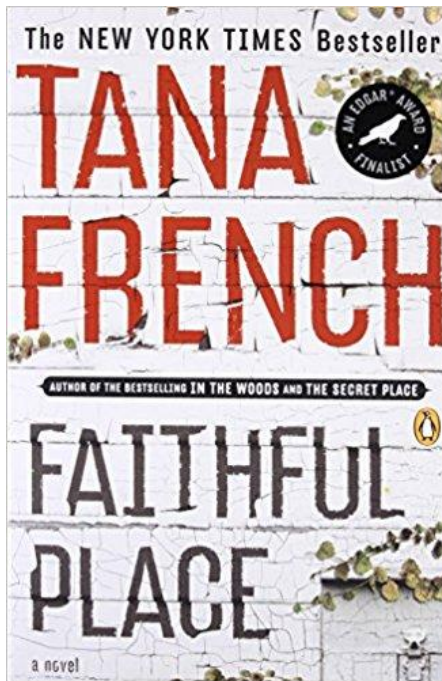
