## St John's Writer's Play Chosen for Theatre Festival

A play by St. John's parishioner Gary Carr has been chosen for Onstage Theatre's One-Act Play Festival, currently running at the Campbell Theater in Martinez.

"Jenny Gets Her Wheels On" is the story of a gravely injured musical theatre ingénue who must find a new way of using her talent. Jenny, the lead character, begins her career as an innocent, like Laurie in Oklahoma. But after an accident, she

metamorphoses into a comedian like Sarah Silverman or Amy Schumer, Carr explains.

"Director Kim Doppe has cast three very flexible actors who are perfect for the roles, especially Anne Baker, who plays Jenny. Anne had to master playing ninety percent of the show maneuvering around in a wheelchair," Carr says in a shameful spoiler alert. He is working to expand this one-act into a full-length play.

The play contains strong language and is definitely not for children. Carr petitions for forgiveness in advance.

The festival of 15 one-act plays runs on weekends through June 24. Performances are at 8:00 pm Thursdays through Saturdays and 2:30 pm on Sundays.

**"Jenny Gets Her Wheels On," along with four other one-acts, can be seen on June 2, 3, 8, 9, 10 at 8:00 pm and June 4 at 2:30 pm.**

The Martinez Campbell Theater is at 636 Ward Street in Martinez, the site of the former Willows Theatre. Street parking is usually ample.
