GO AND VOTE this election 2018!

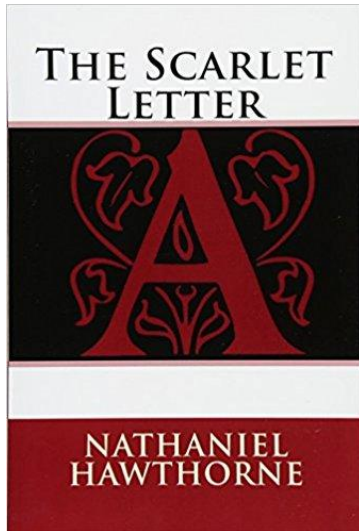
